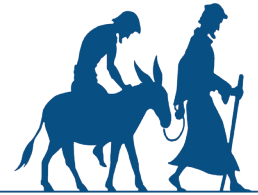

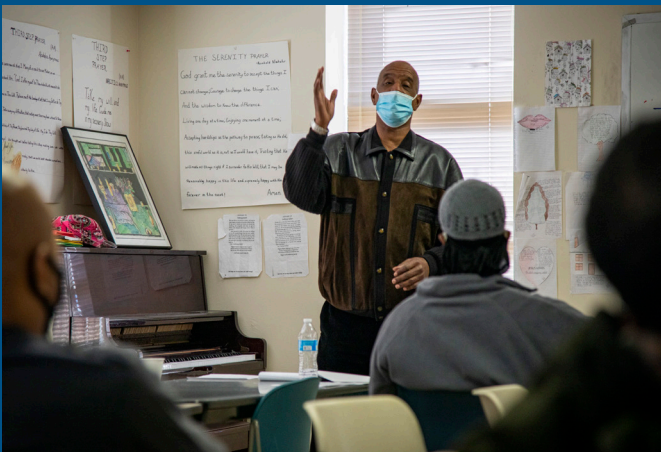
## Our Mission

For over 35 years, our programs and services have helped over 15,000 citizens in the District of Columbia.

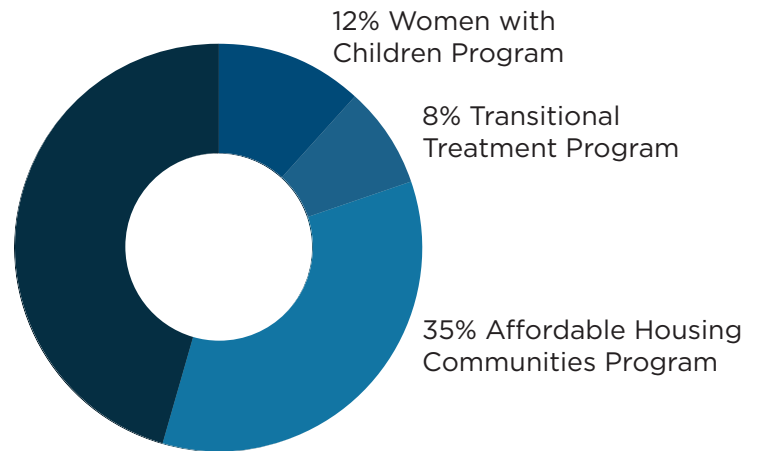

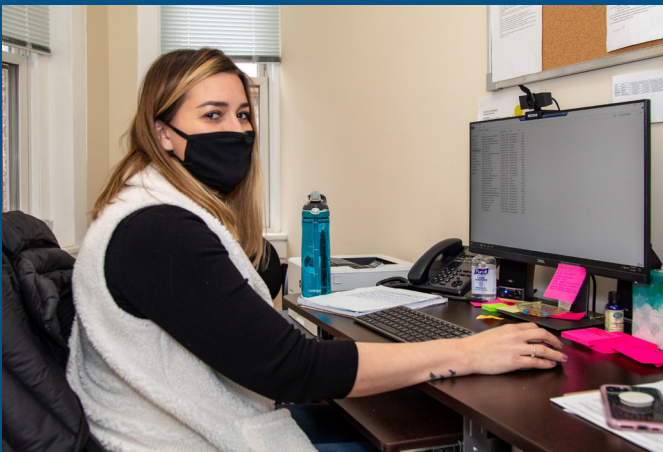
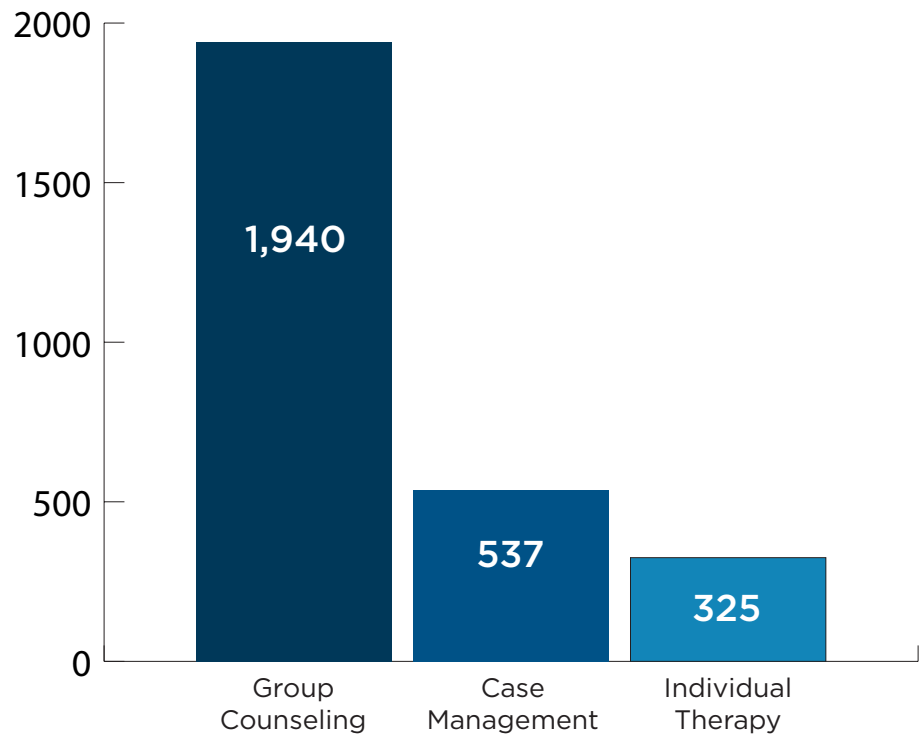
# Our Year in Service

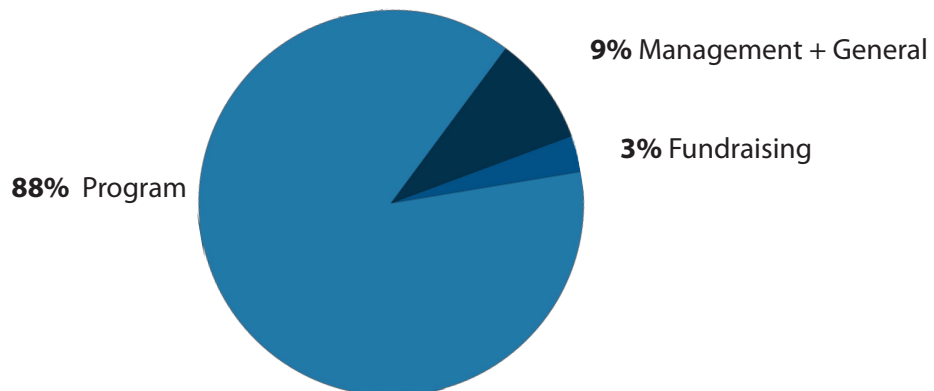




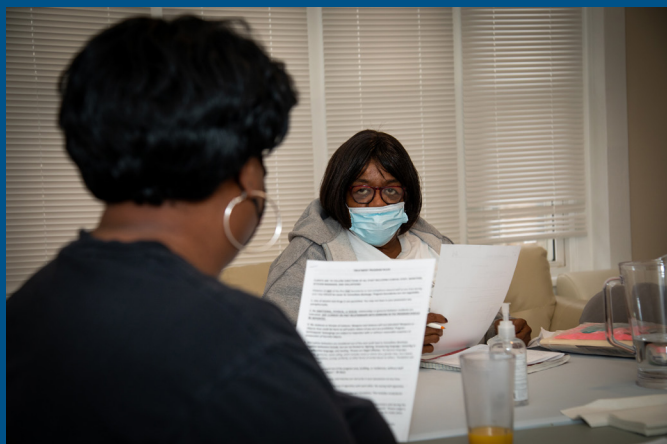
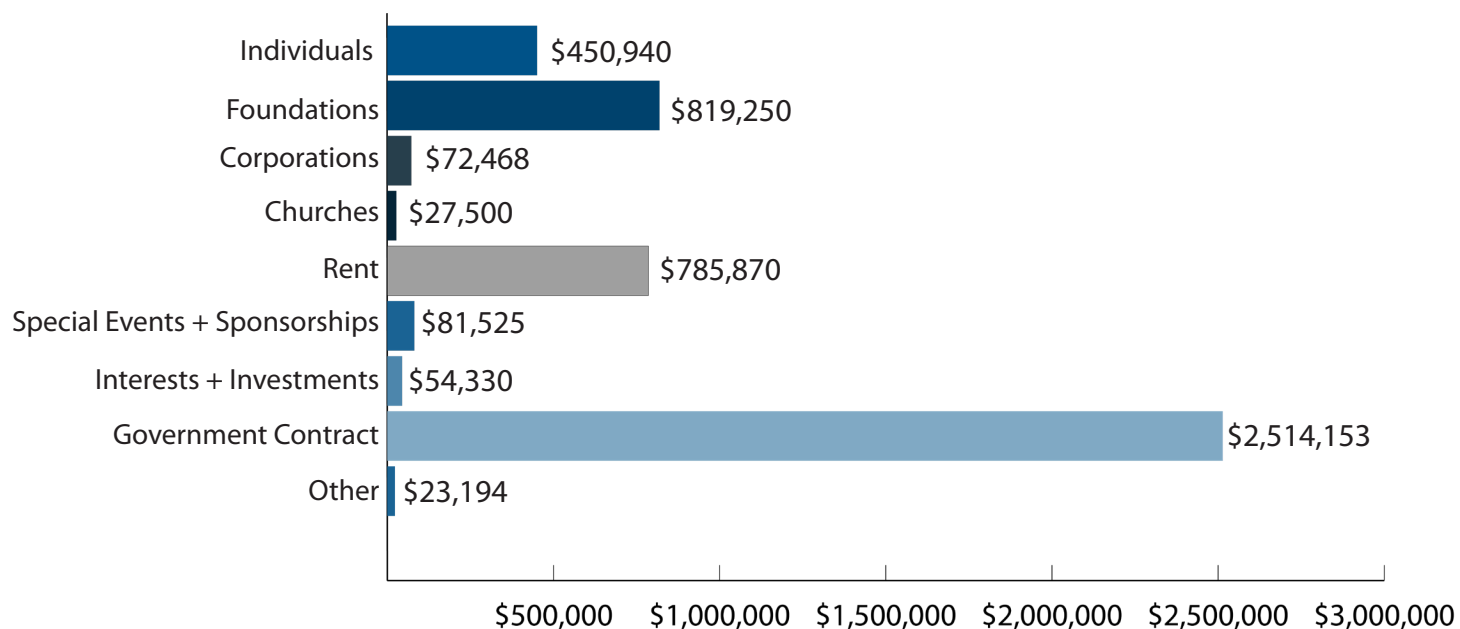
